Special Motion from the Policies working Group to accept the following amendments to Standing Orders to provide clarity on pre-planning protocol:

- a) Add the wording in bold to 27 c ii so it now reads:
- The Chair and Planning Representatives will then decide if a site meeting, which could be open to members of the Public will be held. Until then a councillor is only entitled to view the site from public vantage points and they have no individual rights to enter private property (25a i).
- b) Remove 27 c iii. As this is now clarified by the additional wording in 27 c ii.
- c) Add the following under 27 d I Pre-Planning

A Pre application advice service is provided by Dorset Council at a cost to developers and is available at https://www.dorsetcouncil.gov.uk/planning-buildings-land/planning/pre-application-advice. Developers requiring pre-planning advice are to be advised to make use of this service as the role of the Parish Council in the planning process is as a consultee.

The Working Group feels that current restrictions on Councillor Activities in Standing Order 25 a 1 & ii should largely prohibit Councillors from offering independent opinions to developers outside of directing them to the current Neighbourhood and the Local Plans. If approached by a developer Councillors should encourage them to present their proposals to the full council during a meeting of the council.
